DECLARATION OF CHIA-MIN CHEN

I, Chia Min-Chen, being of sound mind, declare and state as follows:

- (1) I am a citizen of the United States and reside in Cuyahoga County, Ohio at 22051 Kennison Ave., Euclid, OH 44123.
- (2) I am 46 years old and was born in Taiwan. I moved to the United States when I was 11 years of age. I became a citizen of the United States at least ten years ago.
- (3) I have lived in Ohio since 1992.
- (4) I am a registered voter when I became a citizen. I have voted in some primary and most general elections since then. I plan to vote in the November 2006 general election and the elections that follow. My right to vote is precious to me, and I believe it is one of my responsibilities to vote.
- (5) I have also volunteered to register voters.
- (6) It is my understanding that, if my eligibility to vote were challenged at the polls for being a noncitizen, I would be required to present my original certificate of naturalization. I am unsure of where my certificate of naturalization is.
