MOTION FOR ORDER CONFIRMING APPLICABILITY OF STAY OF JUDGMENT UNDER RULE 62(a)

Defendants Representative David R. Lewis, Senator Ralph E. Hise, Jr., Speaker of the North Carolina House Timothy K. Moore, and President Pro Tem of the North Carolina Senate, Philp E. Berger ("Legislative Defendants") and the State of North Carolina¹ (collectively "Defendants") respectfully move the Court for an order affirming that the 30-day post-judgment stay period of Rule 62(a) applies to the Court's remand order and ensuring that the Clerk of Court does not mail the remand order pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1447(d) to the clerk of the North Carolina Superior Court during that 30-day window, i.e., at the earliest, February 4, 2019.
